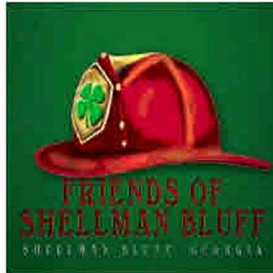


The Friends of Shellman Bluff, Inc.
Scholarship Program
Information Sheet and Application



The Friends of Shellman Bluff, Inc. (FOSB) will be awarding two \$1,000.00 scholarships to a _____ school year graduating senior from McIntosh Academy. The student must attend an accredited college, university, or technical institute and participate full-time in a program designed to lead to a diploma. The recipient must be a resident of the McIntosh County School District for at least two years.

The following is required:

1. Transcript of high school credits
2. GPA of 2.5 or above.

The following information must be typed or computer generated:

1. Letter of recommendation from a teacher in subject matter of major interest.
2. Letter of recommendation from a community leader, clergy or employer.
3. An autobiography of not more than 200 words.
4. Completed application form.

If selected as a scholarship recipient, the student will receive a one-time \$1,000.00 scholarship award. A check will be made payable to the recipient once verification that a 2.0 or better GPA was achieved on all attempted full-time course work for the first semester/quarter of enrollment.

The committee on education and scholarships will select recipients for scholarship awards. Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, future potential, and participation in school and community activities, statement of career and educational aspirations and goals, recommendation and financial need. To ensure that no bias occurs in the selection process for award of scholarships, all interested applicants (high school seniors) must meet the criteria established in the guidelines and application of the program. As an internal quality control measure, the committee on education and scholarships selects recipients for scholarship awards based on needs during the selection process and not by applicants being affiliated with our organization (spouses, family members, etc.). All applicants agree to accept the decision of the committee on education and scholarships. The FOSB Scholarship Committee may interview final candidates.

Interested students should complete the application and submit it to the McIntosh Academy Guidance Office by Wednesday, April 26, 2018.

Applications received ~~after this date~~ will not be considered. Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information submitted to the committee. Scholarship recipients will be announced at Honor's Night
